Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

Public Act 135 of 1989 mandates that **all** permit applications filed by Residential Builders, or other licensed applicants, requires the above information to be obtained.

NOTE: The State Construction Code requires that the contractor whose name appears on the license shall sign all permit applications unless a letter of authorization is on file authorizing that other person to act as the agent for the license holder for the signing of permit applications.

The "letter of authorization" shall be signed by the license holder.
