

### MEASURE

The proportion (percentage) of total hospitalizations considered to be preventable had adequate ambulatory care been received to prevent the onset of an illness or condition, control an acute episode of an illness, or manage a chronic disease or condition in persons under 65 years of age.

### WHY IS THIS INDICATOR IMPORTANT?

A useful measure of access to health care is the number of cases (involving people aged under 65) for which hospitalization usually may be avoided if appropriate out-patient or ambulatory care is available. High hospital admission rates for conditions that could have been prevented by other means may be indirect evidence of a patient-access problem or deficiencies in outpatient management. By definition, the cost of these hospitalizations are avoidable through prevention. There also is some evidence that regions with a greater number of available hospital beds per 1,000 population have a higher rate of preventable hospitalizations.

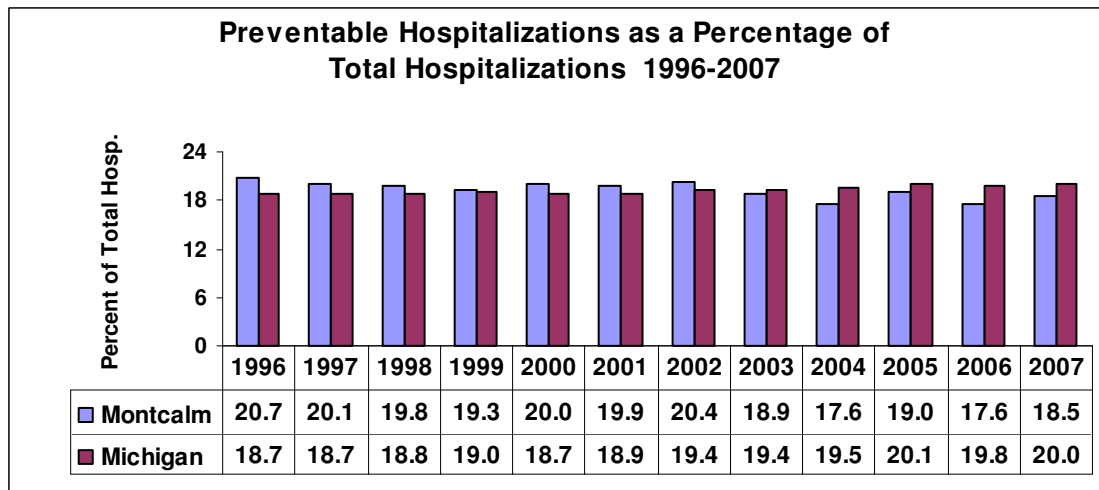
### HOW WELL IS THE MONTCALM COMMUNITY DOING?

For the years 1996 through 2007, Michigan has experienced a slight increase in the percentage of preventable hospitalizations, while Montcalm County has seen a slight decline in the proportion of preventable hospitalizations. The five most recent years recorded (2003-07) suggest the proportion of preventable hospitalizations in Montcalm County have dipped below that of Michigan — a positive trend.

### GOAL FOR MONTCALM COUNTY

Reduce percentage of all preventable hospitalizations in Montcalm County below that of Michigan rate.

HP2010 has set preventable hospitalization goals for two conditions among people below age 65 years to be achieved by the end of this decade - pediatric asthma and uncontrolled adult diabetes. The results and goal for these specific conditions can be seen in the bottom table on this page. As yet, the HP2010 goals have not been consistently achieved.
