Order of Practicability

WILLIAMS INTERCOUNTY DRAIN  
(Kent and Montcalm Counties)

**WHEREAS**, the Williams Intercounty Drain Drainage Board met on January 10, 2024 to consider the petition, dated October 2, 2023, for maintenance and improvement of an intercounty drain pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, to determine the sufficiency of signatures on the petition, go over the route of the intercounty drain, to determine whether the addition of Montcalm County to the drainage district is just and equitable, pursuant to Section 135, to further determine whether the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain is practicable; and

**WHEREAS**, said Drainage Board after hearing the evidence offered made its determination upon the sufficiency of signatures on the petition, the addition of Montcalm County to the drainage district, and whether the proposed drain project is practicable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DETERMINED** by a majority vote of the Drainage Board, that the petition contains a sufficient number of eligible signatures as provided in Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended.


**IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED AND DETERMINED** by a majority vote of the Drainage Board that the addition of Montcalm County to the drainage district is ✓ just and equitable.


